PESA Post-Graduate Scholarship For Research In Geosciences

For a post-graduate student (already holding a BSc or BA with or without Honours) at an Australian Tertiary Education Institution, undertaking a research project with relevance to Petroleum Geology or Geophysics, e.g. sedimentology, basin analysis, geophysical modeling, seismic interpretation, paleontology, petroleum geology, etc. etc.

Deadline for applications: 31st October 2009

Selection: The award will be made to the student with the best grades, record of relevant achievements and research most relevant to the petroleum industry. These factors are equally weighted.

Requirements: The award will usually be made at a PESA Seminar Luncheon in the recipient's city of residence, where the recipient will be asked to give a ten minute presentation of their research effort

Details of Scholarship: The **\$5000** award is made payable to the student to assist with their postgraduate studies. This may be used towards university fees, subsistence, or project costs such as data, travel and accommodation.
