

The Western Australian branch of the Petroleum Exploration Society of Australia (PESA WA) in association with Woodside Energy Ltd is offering awards to eligible students currently studying a petroleum exploration related discipline. The aim of the program is to promote and encourage petroleum related research and education in Western Australia. In 2017, AUD\$6,000 of awards will be available to be distributed to distinguished students who are currently under taking full time study at a Western Australian university.

The awards are open to students undertaking:

- Woodside – PESA WA Third Year Scholarship (two awards of \$500)
- Woodside – PESA WA Honours Scholarship (two awards of \$1000)
- Woodside – PESA WA Masters Scholarship by coursework or research (two awards of \$1500)

Eligibility criteria and guidelines are provided below. Application form is included on page 2.

## ELIGIBILITY

The Woodside-PESA WA Scholarship Program is open to students who, at the application deadline, are:

1. Enrolled as a third year, higher undergraduate or post-graduate student in a geology or geophysics program at The University of Western Australia or Curtin University;
2. A current student member of PESA.

## PESA MEMBERSHIP

Students wishing to be considered for a Woodside-PESA WA Scholarship for the current year need to be approved PESA members at the time awards are considered. Student membership is \$27.50/year and includes free access to the PESA library and subsidised attendance at technical lunches and short courses. Applications should be received by the committee prior to the application deadline of **31st August 2017**

## SELECTION PROCEDURE

Applications will be assessed by the PESA WA scholarship committee. Successful applicants will be notified and invited to a technical luncheon on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2017 to receive their award. Honours and MSc candidates are requested to provide an article about their current research for the PESA News magazine (see below). The article of highest merit will be published in PESA News.

## HOW TO APPLY

Applicants must include the following in their application:

- a completed Application Form;
- a certified copy of their Tertiary Academic Record;
- Honours and MSc Candidates should include a short article (<2 pages) about their research project, which is suitable for publication in the PESA news magazine.
