## **PESA Qld 2018 Honours/Postgraduate Annual Scholarship in Geoscience**

# **\$2000**

For an Honours or MSc student at a Queensland Tertiary Education Institution, undertaking a research project with relevance to Petroleum Geology or Geophysics, (e.g., sedimentology, basin analysis, geophysics, organic geochemistry, structural geology, palaeontology, petroleum geology, petrophysics, sequence stratigraphy, etc.). A mid-year entry Honours student may apply in their first or second year, but funding in the first year will be contingent on the proposed project being taken up. An unsuccessful application in the first year will limit their ability to apply in the second year.

***Deadline for applications***                      **Wednesday 26 September 2018**

***Selection***    The award will be made to the student with the best grades and the project most relevant to the petroleum industry. The recipient shall either be a current student member of PESA or have made an application for membership. Student membership is free.

***Requirements***                                      The award will usually be made at a PESA Technical Luncheon in Brisbane. The recipient will be required to give a presentation of their results at a PESA Technical Luncheon and publish an abstract in *PESA News* after submission of their thesis. Prior written approval for the presentation and abstract publication must be obtained from any sponsoring company before the award can be made.

***Expenditure***                                        The award is made payable to the student to assist with their Honours or postgraduate studies. This may include university fees, subsistence, or project costs such as data, travel, and accommodation.
